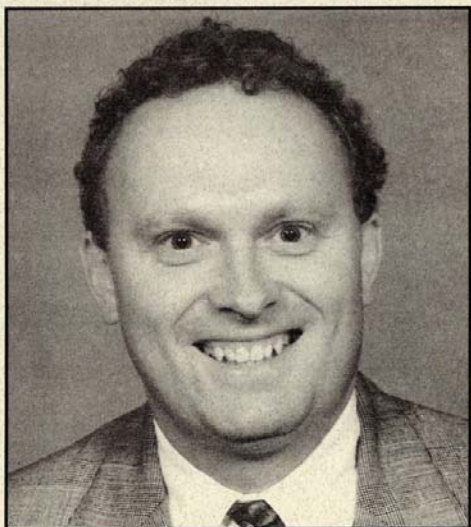

ARCHIE EDGAR

IN THE MID 1970'S, SOCCER WAS A RELATIVELY NEW SPORT AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL AS WELL AS THE CLEVELAND AREA. SLOWLY BUT SURELY AREA HIGH SCHOOLS BEGAN TO START SOCCER PROGRAMS AND THE NORTH OLMSTED PROGRAM WAS LEADING THE WAY. ARCHIE EDGAR WAS A BIG REASON WHY. ARCHIE WAS ONE OF THE FIRST BIG STARS IN LOCAL HIGH SCHOOL SOCCER AS WELL AS ONE OF NORTH OLMSTED'S FIRST STARS. IN 1975 ARCHIE LED THE EAGLES TO THEIR FIRST EVER WINNING SEASON IN SOCCER. IN THAT SAME SEASON, ARCHIE WAS NAMED A FIRST TEAM ALL OHIO SELECTION. THIS WAS THE FIRST POST SEASON HONOR FOR THE NORTH OLMSTED SOCCER PROGRAM. HISTORY WAS BEING MADE.

IN 1976, INJURIES SEEMED TO PLAGUE ARCHIE BUT HE BOUNCED BACK IN 1977. ONCE AGAIN A FIRST TEAM ALL STATE SELECTION, ARCHIE THIS TIME LED HIS TEAM TO THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WHERE THEY PLAYED CINCINNATI ROGER BACON HIGH SCHOOL. ARCHIE SCORED ONE GOAL IN THAT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND THE EAGLES WENT ON TO WIN THEIR FIRST STATE TEAM TITLE. ARCHIE TO THIS DATE IS ONE OF ONLY TWO PLAYERS IN NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL SOCCER HISTORY TO BE NAMED FIRST TEAM ALL STATE TWO TIMES. ARCHIE WAS VOTED CAPTAIN OF THE 1977 TEAM AND WAS ALSO VOTED THE TEAM'S MOST OUTSTANDING PLAYER.

AFTER GRADUATING FROM NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, ARCHIE CONTINUED HIS SOCCER CAREER AT BOWLING GREEN STATE UNIVERSITY WHERE HE EARNED A BUSINESS DEGREE.
