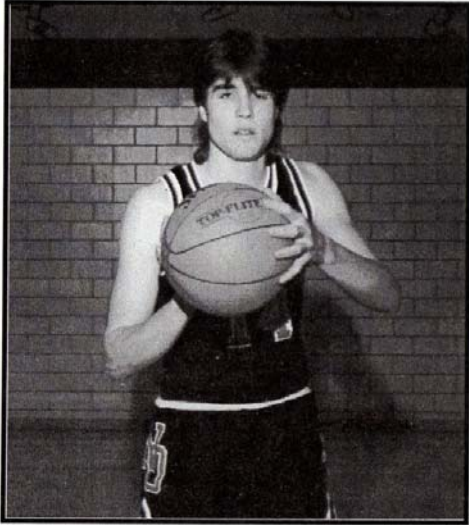

BRETT CORENO

A 1991 GRADUATE OF NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, BRETT WAS AN OUTSTANDING BASEBALL AND BASKETBALL PLAYER. AS IS THE CASE WITH MANY HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL PLAYERS, BRETT PLAYED TWO POSITIONS. A STRONG FIRST BASEMAN WITH OUTSTANDING RANGE WAS HIS POSITION WHEN HE WAS NOT BEING CALLED ON TO BE THE CLOSER FOR AN EAGLES WIN. IT WAS THE SPORT OF BASKETBALL THOUGH THAT BRETT EXCELLED IN AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL AND PRIOR TO HIS GRADUATION, THE RECORD BOOKS HAD BEEN REWRITTEN.

THE HONORS BEGAN IN HIS SOPHOMORE YEAR WHEN BRETT EARNED ALL- SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE SECOND TEAM HONORS. IN THE 1989-1990 BASKETBALL SEASON, BRETT HAD A BREAKOUT YEAR EARNING FIRST TEAM ALL- SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE, FIRST TEAM ALL- AKRON BEACON JOURNAL, FIRST TEAM PLAIN DEALER AND HONORABLE MENTION ALL- STATE. AS A SENIOR, IT WAS DIFFICULT TO CHRONICLE ALL THE HONORS THAT BRETT HAD ACHIEVED. SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER, CO-PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN NORTHEASTERN OHIO, LEADING SCORER IN THE CITY OF CLEVELAND, SECOND TEAM ALL- STATE, AKRON BEACON JOURNAL FIRST TEAM, CHRONICLE FIRST TEAM AND NAMED AS ONE OF THE TOP TEN PLAYERS IN THE CITY OF CLEVELAND.

CURRENTLY, BRETT IS THE ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER IN NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL HISTORY WITH 1,350 POINTS AND HOLDS THE RECORD FOR MOST FREE THROWS MADE IN A GAME (19), MOST FREE THROWS MADE IN A SEASON (115), AND MOST FREE THROWS MADE IN A CAREER (224).

UPON GRADUATING FROM NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, BRETT WENT ON TO AN OUTSTANDING CAREER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF RIO GRANDE WHERE HE WAS A TWO-TIME NAIA ALL AMERICAN AND A TWO-TIME MID-OHIO PLAYER OF THE YEAR.
