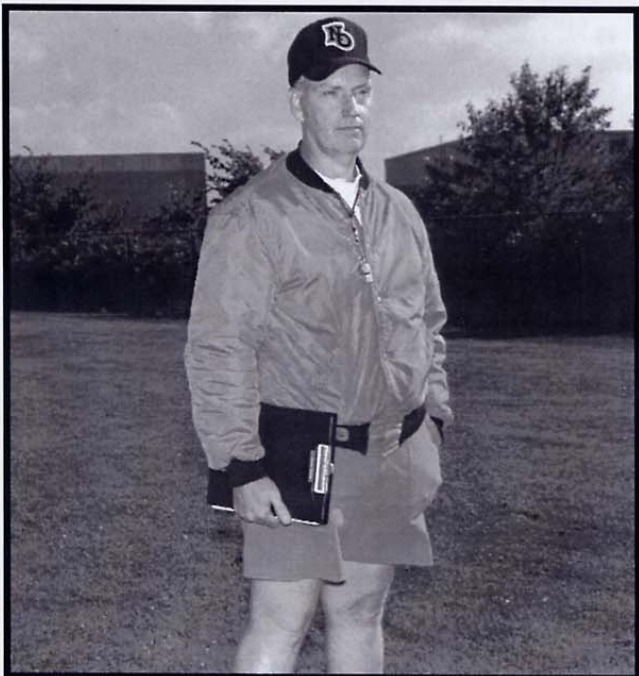


JERRY BOGGS

JERRY BOGGS

A 1952 GRADUATE OF RAVENNA HIGH SCHOOL, JERRY HAD AN OUTSTANDING HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL CAREER BEFORE MATRICULATING TO BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE WHERE HE ALSO PARTICIPATED IN FOOTBALL.

HIS HIGH SCHOOL TEACHING AND COACHING CAREER STARTED AT DOYLESTOWN HIGH SCHOOL IN 1957. AS AN ASSISTANT FOOTBALL AND BASEBALL COACH, JERRY HAD QUITE A BIT OF SUCCESS WITH A STRING OF 20 STRAIGHT IN FOOTBALL AND A STATE RUNNER UP TITLE IN BASEBALL. AFTER SIX YEARS JERRY MOVED TO FREDERICKTOWN WHERE HE POSTED A CAREER FOOTBALL RECORD OF 52-15-2 AFTER SEVEN YEARS.

IN 1969, THE NORTH OLMSTED TENURE BEGAN. FROM 1969 TO 1987 JERRY WAS AT THE HELM OF THE NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL PROGRAM. AFTER TEN YEARS, JERRY POSTED A 57-32-5 RECORD, WAS THE 1977 SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR AND WON THREE SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS. NOT BEING ABLE TO QUITE GET THE COACHING OUT OF HIS SYSTEM, JERRY ASSISTED COACH TOM WATTS FOR FOUR YEARS AND LATER WENT ON TO BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE WHERE HE COACHED FOR SEVERAL MORE YEARS.

IN REFLECTING BACK ON HIS NORTH OLMSTED YEARS, JERRY RECALLS THE FRIENDSHIPS HE MADE AND THE OUTSTANDING PEOPLE THAT HE HAD THE CHANCE TO WORK WITH (PAUL RHODES, JOE KERKA). HE ALSO FEELS VERY FORTUNATE TO HAVE WORKED IN SUCH A FINE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND ENJOYED THE MANY OUTSTANDING STUDENT-ATHLETES THAT HE HAD THE PRIVILEGE TO MEET AND COACH.
