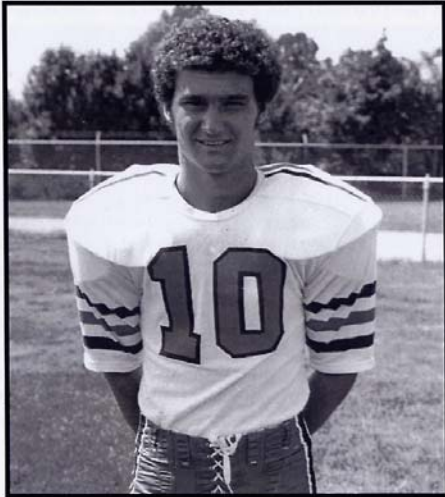

DINO MASTANTUONO

AN ALL-SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE PERFORMER IN FOOTBALL, WRESTLING AND TRACK, DINO IS HERALDED AS ONE OF THE FINEST ATHLETES IN THE HISTORY OF NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL. AS A THREE YEAR STARTING QUARTERBACK IN FOOTBALL, DINO COULD NOT ONLY BEAT YOU WITH HIS ARM, BUT WAS ALSO A REAL THREAT WITH THE TRACK SPEED HE POSSESSED. IN 1977, DINO LED THE EAGLES TO A SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP AND WAS ALSO NAMED TO THE ALL-SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE TEAM.

AS A WRESTLER, DINO HAD A STELLAR CAREER. A TWO-TIME ALL-SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPION AND DISTRICT CHAMPION AS WELL, DINO ALSO HELPED LEAD HIS TEAM TO TWO SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS IN 1978 AND 1979.

IN THE SPRINGTIME, DINO MADE HIS HOME ON THE NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL TRACK. A TWO-TIME SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE 100 YARD DASH CHAMPION, DINO ALSO WAS THE CONFERENCE CHAMP IN THE 200 YARD DASH AND WAS A MEMBER OF THE SCHOOL RECORD MILE RELAY TEAM THAT QUALIFIED FOR THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. DINO ALSO HELD THE RECORD FOR THE 100-YARD DASH AS HE WAS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE BOYS 1979 SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP.

AFTER GRADUATING FROM NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, DINO CONTINUED HIS ACADEMIC AND ATHLETIC CAREER AT BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE WHERE HE CONTINUED TO COMPETE IN THREE SPORTS JUST AS SUCCESSFULLY AS HE DID AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL (ALL-OHIO ATHLETIC CONFERENCE RUNNING BACK IN FOOTBALL, ALL-OHIO ATHLETIC CONFERENCE CHAMPION IN WRESTLING AND A 100 METER FINALIST IN TRACK).
