COACH TOM HATFIELD SAID IT BEST, "KEVIN TERRY WAS A SCORING PHENOMENON FROM THE VERY BEGINNING OF HIS HIGH SCHOOL SOCCER CAREER." KEVIN ALSO PARTICIPATED IN TRACK AND TENNIS WHILE ATTENDING NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, BUT CLEARLY SOCCER WAS HIS GAME. SOME OF KEVIN'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN SOCCER INCLUDED: ALL SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE IN 1976 AND 1977, SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER IN 1977, ALL MIDWEST IN 1977, ALL AMERICAN IN 1977, ALL STATE IN 1976 AND 1977, ALL WESTERN DIVISION. ONE OF KEVIN'S MOST REMARKABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS MAY HAVE BEEN WHEN HE SCORED SEVEN GOALS AGAINST BRUSH IN THE DISTRICT FINAL GAME IN THE STATE PLAYOFFS IN 1976. HIS CAREER TOTAL OF ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTEEN GOALS STILL STANDS AS THE SCHOOL RECORD AS DOES HIS CAREER POINT TOTAL OF ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY NINE.

AFTER GRADUATING FROM NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, KEVIN ENROLLED AT CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY WHERE HE ATTENDED SCHOOL AND PLAYED SOCCER FOR TWO YEARS. AT THE AGE OF TWENTY, KEVIN EMBARKED ON A PROFESSIONAL CAREER WITH THE CLEVELAND FORCE. HIS PROFESSIONAL CAREER LASTED FOR ABOUT FIVE YEARS DURING WHICH TIME HE PLAYED FOR THREE DIFFERENT TEAMS.

KEVIN HAS FOND MEMORIES OF HIS DAYS AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL. HE SPEAKS OFTEN OF HIS TEAMMATES AND THE CLOSENESS THEY STILL HAVE TODAY. HE CHERISHES HIS FRIENDSHIP WITH HIS COACH AND FRIEND, TOM HATFIELD. ONE OF HIS FONDEST MEMORIES IS A PHOTOGRAPH HE HAS IN HIS POSSESSION OF HE AND HIS FATHER IN AN EMBRACE RIGHT AFTER HE SCORED THE WINNING GOAL IN THE REGIONAL FINAL TO ADVANCE THE TEAM TO THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.
