ONE OF THE FINEST FEMALE ATHLETES TO EVER WALK THE HALLS OF NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, MICHELLE WAS AN OUTSTANDING BASKETBALL PLAYER AND AN EVEN GREATER TRACK ATHLETE. FROM 1986 THROUGH 1988, MICHELLE SET A NEW STANDARD IN NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS TRACK AS WELL AS IN THE SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE. THROUGHOUT HER FOUR YEARS, MICHELLE WAS A CONFERENCE CHAMPION IN FOUR DIFFERENT EVENTS. THESE EVENTS INCLUDED THE LONG JUMP, 100 METER DASH, 200 METER DASH AND THE FOUR BY 200 YARD RELAY. AS WELL AS BEING A FOUR EVENT SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPION. SHE ALSO HOLDS THREE NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL RECORDS AS WELL. SHE CURRENTLY IS THE SCHOOL RECORD HOLDER IN THE 100 METER DASH, THE LONG JUMP AND THE 200 METER DASH. MICHELLE WAS ALSO A TWO YEAR STARTING FORWARD ON THE BASKETBALL TEAM. HER JUNIOR YEAR, MICHELLE WAS THE SECOND LEADING SCORER ON THE 1986-87 SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP BASKETBALL TEAM.

AT ASHLAND COLLEGE, MICHELLE CONTINUED HER ILLUSTRIOUS TRACK CAREER. SHE BECAME AN ALL-AMERICAN IN TRACK AND FIELD AND WAS A SEVEN TIME QUALIFIER FOR THE NCAA TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS. WHILE BECOMING THE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER ON THE WOMENS TRACK TEAM THREE YEARS IN A ROW, MICHELLE WAS ALSO DOING THE JOB IN THE CLASSROOM AS SHE WAS A MULTIPLE DEANS LIST STUDENT.

MICHELLE STILL RESIDES IN NORTH OLMSTED AND IS MARRIED AND HAS TWO SONS. SHE ENJOYS RECREATIONAL SPORTS AND SPENDING TIME WITH HER FAMILY.
