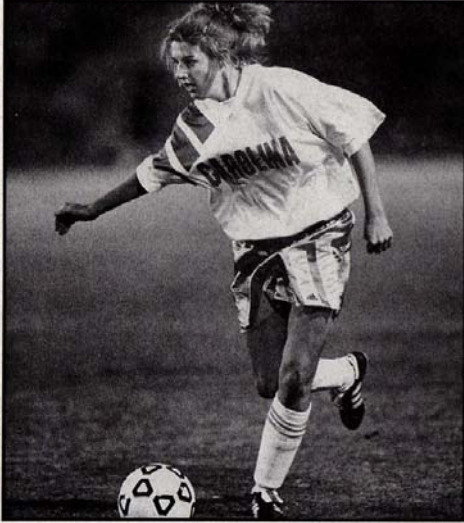


## PAMELA KALINOSKI

PAMELA WAS TRULY AN OUTSTANDING ATHLETE WHO PARTICIPATED IN FOUR DIFFERENT VARSITY SPORTS WHILE ATTENDING NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL. PAMELA PARTICIPATED IN SOFTBALL AND TRACK, BUT BASKETBALL WAS THE GAME IN WHICH SHE SEEMED TO EXCEL. AN ALL FIRST TEAM SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE PERFORMER, PAMELA WAS KNOWN FOR HER UNSELFISH STYLE OF PLAY. IN FACT, UNTIL THIS PAST BASKETBALL SEASON, SHE HELD THE ALL TIME ASSIST RECORD FOR GIRLS BASKETBALL AND WAS NAMED THE TEAM'S MOST VALUABLE PLAYER. IN PAM'S JUNIOR YEAR, GIRLS SOCCER WAS ADDED TO THE HIGH SCHOOL INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC PROGRAM. THE REST IS HISTORY. HER SOCCER HONORS AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL INCLUDED FIRST TEAM ALL SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE, MOST VALUABLE PLAYER OF THE SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE, NORTH-EAST PLAYER OF THE YEAR TWO YEARS IN A ROW, ALL STATE AND ALL AMERICAN.

AFTER HER GRADUATION FROM NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, PAMELA ENROLLED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA WHERE SHE EARNED A DEGREE IN SPEECH COMMUNICATION. HER SOCCER HONORS AT NORTH CAROLINA INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING: SOCCER AMERICA ALL FRESHMAN TEAM, NCAA FINAL FOUR ALL TOURNAMENT TEAM IN 1988 AND 1991, NCAA ALL TOURNAMENT OFFENSIVE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER, SECOND TEAM ALL AMERICAN IN 1991, ALL SOUTH 1991, CAREER ASSISTS CO- LEADER, CO-CAPTAIN IN 1991, AND NCAA DIVISION I NATIONAL CHAMPION FOUR TIMES.

PAMELA FELT SHE HAD AN INCREDIBLE EXPERIENCE AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL. IN HER OWN WORDS, "I FEEL BLESSED WITH THE OPPORTUNITY THE HIGH SCHOOL PROVIDED ME IN ATHLETICS AND ACADEMICS."

AFTER HER STELLAR CAREER AT NORTH CAROLINA, PAMELA WENT INTO COACHING WHERE SHE WAS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT MEMPHIS STATE UNIVERSITY AND PRESENTLY IS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SAN FRANCISCO.
