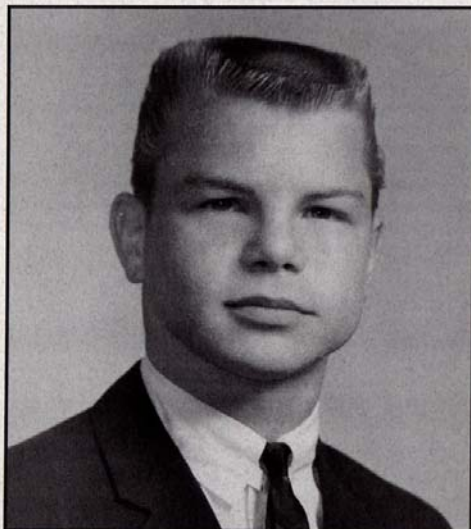


ROGER TRESCH

AN OUTSTANDING WRESTLER IN HIS CAREER AT NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL, ROGER IS BELIEVED TO BE THE FIRST EVER INDIVIDUAL STATE CHAMPION IN THE SCHOOL'S HISTORY. LETTERING IN WRESTLING IN 1961, 1962, AND 1963, ROGER ALSO BECAME THE SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPION IN 1962 AND 1963. ALSO IN 1962, ROGER WON THE DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP ON HIS WAY TO WINNING THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. IN 1963, ROGER CLOSED OUT HIS HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLING CAREER WITH A THIRD PLACE FINISH AT THE STATE WRESTLING MEET. ROGER ALSO PARTICIPATED IN FOOTBALL WHILE ATTENDING NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL. KNOWN AS AN OUTSTANDING ATHLETE, FEW PEOPLE ARE AWARE OF ROGER'S TALENTS AS A GYMNAST. IN 1962, ROGER ACTUALLY WON THE OHIO JUNIOR OLYMPIC ALL AROUND GYMNASTICS CHAMPIONSHIP.

MEMORABLE MOMENTS IN ROGER'S CAREER INCLUDE REPRESENTING HIS ALMA MATER AT THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. ROGER HAS EXPRESSED HIS THANKS FOR THE SUPPORT FROM ALL OF HIS COACHES, TEACHERS AND FELLOW STUDENTS. TEACHERS WHO HAD A STRONG INFLUENCE ON ROGER'S LIFE INCLUDE RAY WILSON AND TOM HATFIELD.

AFTER GRADUATING FROM NORTH OLMSTED HIGH SCHOOL ROGER ATTENDED OHIO UNIVERSITY AND LETTERED IN WRESTLING FOR THREE YEARS.

ROGER HAS STAYED INVOLVED WITH WRESTLING OVER THE YEARS BY STARTING AND COACHING THE ST. MARY OF THE FALLS WRESTLING PROGRAM. HE IS ALSO INVOLVED WITH THE ST. MARY OF THE FALLS ATHLETIC BOOSTERS AND THE OLMSTED FALLS KIWANIS. ROGER AND HIS WIFE ARE THE PROUD PARENTS OF FOUR CHILDREN.
