SALLY WAS AN OUTSTANDING DISTANCE RUNNER ON BOTH THE CROSS COUNTRY AND TRACK TEAM. IN FACT, SHE WAS THE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER FOR BOTH OF THESE TEAMS. A TWO-TIME ALL SOUTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPION IN THE 880 YARD RUN, SHE STILL HOLDS THE SCHOOL RECORD FOR BOTH THE 880 AND ALSO THE MILE. SALLY WAS A TWO TIME STATE QUALIFIER AND I BELIEVE THE FIRST FEMALE ATHLETE TO PLACE IN STATE COMPETITION. ALSO RECOGNIZED AS A LEADER AMONG HER PEERS, SALLY WAS CAPTAIN OF BOTH THE CROSS COUNTRY AND TRACK TEAM.

AS A DEAN'S LIST STUDENT AT MARIETTA COLLEGE, SALLY CONTINUED HER COMPETITIVE RUNNING ON THE CROSS COUNTRY TEAM WHERE SHE BECAME THE MOST VALUABLE RUNNER ON HER COLLEGE TEAM.
